

General Terms & Conditions

AIP Junior Spanish Summer Program

Accommodation

- Price of accommodation in a host family includes full board, laundry, and other services as specified in the Students' & Parents' guide.
- Our host families exclusively collaborate with our school. Participants won't share their rooms with students from other schools. As an exception, there might more than one student from our school living with the same host family, but he/she will always be from another country.
- AIP will provide host family details 2 weeks prior to the participants' arrival.

Starting dates and course length

- Participants can choose to stay from 1 week up to 6 weeks (First day: June 30th; last day: August 11th).
- Participants can choose the starting date of their preference: June 30th, July 7th, 14th, 21st or 28th and August 4th. If the student is older than 15, he/she can extend his/her stay in our Spanish school for adults.

Arrival & Departure

- Each program week goes from Saturday to Saturday.
- For every additional day, we charge each junior student with 36€ for a full-board stay with a host family.

Transfer service

- A member of each host family or, failing that, a staff member of AIP Languages will be waiting for each participant at the airport upon their arrival and will take him/her to the host family house. The journey can be made either by car or public transport. Same conditions apply on departure day.
- If a participant is due to arrive between 10.30 pm to 7.00 am, AIP Languages will send a properly identified driver to pick him/her up. This service has a charge of 52€ per trip.

Important notes

- Our school has a daily schedule with lessons starting at 9 am and finishing around 1 pm; and then, afternoon/evening activities. Depending on the activity and its starting time, participants might or might not be able to go back home for lunch. All participants are responsible for arriving at school on time as well as going back home once the activities are over. We always try to accommodate students in apartments located as close as possible to the school, though, sometimes, their accommodation may not be within walking distance from the school.
- Valencia is a very safe city with an excellent system of public transportation, including metro, tram and buses. Each participant is provided with a 10-trip travel card, recharged every week, and will be instructed about how to use local public transport properly for his/her daily transfer, by the host family and AIP staff. Juniors learn really fast how to cope with this without any further assistance, which also becomes a big part of their immersion experience, clearly contributing to their personal growth and citizenship skills.

Booking and payment conditions

- In order to book a place in the program, participants need to pay 160€ in advance, as a deposit, and fill in our Enrolment Form. The deposit can be paid via bank transfer, credit card or PayPal. This amount will then be deducted from the final price of the course, and final payment should be made one month before the beginning of the course, the latest.
- If payment is made via bank transfer, please send us a copy of the bank receipt with the name of the student by email as soon as it is completed. These are the main details of our bank account:

All bank charges are your responsibility.

- Upon receipt of the deposit (160 €), AIP will send you an email to confirm your admission to the specified program.

Cancellation policy

- In case of cancellation, the course deposit (160 €) will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 70% of the total cost of the program will be refunded when canceling at least 25 days prior to arrival. 50% will be refunded when canceling up to 14 days before arrival. And no refund will be made when cancellation is made less than 2 weeks before arrival.
- There is no refund for days missed of the program or for a late arrival or early departure.

- Changing host family: Should a student wish to change host family, AIP will do so after giving due consideration and in discussion with both student and family. It will take no more than 24h except if the problem comes on the weekend, as it would be necessary to wait until Monday.

Insurance & health

- We strongly recommend junior participants to get a full travel and health insurance cover before coming to Spain, especially if the participant is from a non-EU country. If necessary, AIP can provide a full private insurance.
- EU Nationals should bring E111 Forms. All participants are advised to get an insurance that covers loss of fees and/or expenses that may incur due to cancellation or sudden early departure from the program.

Visas

- Nationals of the following countries do not require a visa for stays of up to 90 days: (a) EU countries, Australia, Canada, Japan, and US. (b) Brazil, Croatia, Cyprus, Iceland, Israel, Korea (Rep. Of), Liechtenstein, Malaysia, Malta, Monaco, Netherlands Antilles, New Zealand, San Marino, Singapore, Switzerland and Vatican City, apart from other Latin American countries. Those staying longer than 90 days may require a student visa except EU country nationals.
- The school will give assistance to students when applying for a Visa.
- A 6-8-week period is necessary for the Visa application process to be over. So, bear this in mind when registering for a course and choosing the dates of it.

- When being interested in booking a place in the Junior Spanish Summer Program, a 500€ deposit must be paid as proof of real interest in taking the course, together with the 160€ deposit of the course reservation. Both of them will be deducted from the final price if the visa is accepted and the participant can come to join the program. In the event that the application for a Visa is refused by the Spanish Embassy or Consulate, we will refund the entire visa deposit, but not the 160€ course deposit.

General conditions

- There will be a number of emergency calls available 24h. If it is necessary to change the participant to a new host family, we will arrange that within 24h.
- AIP Languages does not assume any responsibility for loss, delay or accident of any kind whatsoever that may occur due to fault or negligence of any company or individuals carrying out auxiliary arrangements.
- AIP Languages reserves the right to cancel any arrangements or bookings without prior notice if payment conditions are not met. i.e., in the event of the outstanding amount of the Program has not been covered within the given timeframe.
- AIP Languages reserves the right to dismiss any student for misconduct or at any time the participant violates the rules of the center in which the Program is carried out, lacking discipline, repeated bad behavior, drug abuse, minors consuming alcohol, dangerous conduct to the student or others, or engages in criminal behavior. Whether or not the student's behavior justifies dismissal from the programs shall be within the sole discretion of AIP.

In such case, the Participant or his/her legal representatives shall bear the costs caused by Participant's return to the home country: the cancelation fee, return trip, compensation to the third parties for the damages done and arising from, and for those that AIP will be forced to make as a consequence of the Participant's actions, regardless of any other responsibility due to Participant's misconduct and negligence.

- In the event that an emergency that requires surgery, hospitalization, or other medical care, Advisers for International Programs in Spain, S.L will take any action deeming appropriate under the circumstances, including but not limited to arranging for medical or psychiatric treatment, the administration of prescription drugs, and transportation back to his/her country. AIP Language Institute will not cover costs that may arise as a result of the need for repatriation of student
- In accordance with the right to the self-image, regulated by the law 5/1982 on 5th of May, signing these general conditions, the Participant or his/her legal representative authorize AIP S. L. to use the images taken during the program in order carry out advertising.
- Conflict resolution. Any conflict that may arise between the parties regarding the interpretation, compliance and execution of this contract will be resolved by the competent jurisdictional organizations under applicable law.
